Guide to How You Can Participate in The Youth Livestock Sale

Saturday, March 26th at 10 a.m. – Live “In Person” Auction

- You may attend in person on Saturday, March 26th at 10 a.m.
- If you are not able to join in person, you can fill out the Buyer’s commitment form and we can call you when the exhibitor you are interested in helping will be in the ring for the sale or you can do a proxy bid before the sale.
- Call our BID LINE at 863-733-5030 and we can take your bids over the phone. This number rolls over to 5 additional lines. You can always text 863-781-1146 if you have questions.
- Sale Order
 - Market Steers (We will be selling approximately 29 Head)
 - Market Hogs (Approximately 150 head)
- Your purchase from the youth livestock sale is eligible for a tax-deduction/charitable gift and helps support youth with their project and encourages them to stay involved in agriculture. Therefore, consult your tax advisor on what deductible amount will be.

- All pre-registered buyers that purchase will have their logo displayed during the Youth Livestock Sale and all sale day registered buyers that purchase will have their name displayed during the sale.
- All animals will be sold by the head.
- The following is estimated averages that a Swine and Steer Exhibitor would need to break-even on their project:
 - Swine - \$3.80 per pound or \$950 per head**
 - Steer - \$2.50 per pound or \$3,125 per head**

Again, this is an estimated break-even price and does not account for the youth’s labor in the project, so by paying above these prices, you are helping these exhibitors make a profit on their projects.
- Don’t have time to participate in the sale, but want to help kids with their project, just call us or donate on our website and we will put your money to good use for the kids and report back to you on how you were able to help youth in agriculture. You can also donate the meat from the project to a local charity, such as Lighthouse Ministries, Salvation Army, Talbot House & Florida Baptist Children’s Home, etc., or other charities of your choice and we will help you with this process from the meat packer.

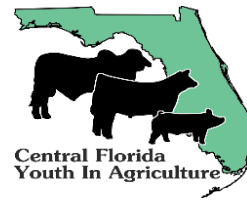

Resell to Packer – Packer price per pound set at beginning of sale. As the buyer of the animal if you don’t want the meat, you can let the Packer take the steer and you pay the bid price minus the packer price.

All animals will be sold by the head, not by the pound.

Estimated breakeven amounts for the youth exhibitors are \$950 per head for swine and \$3,125 for steers. This is only an estimate and does not account for the significant amount of time invested. Profit above the breakeven amount helps the exhibitors invest in their future market animal projects and save for their college education or vocational programs.

Finished market steers are expected to average 1200-1400 lbs.

Finished market swine are expected to average 250-300 lbs.

Market price for the sell-back option is estimated to be \$1.00/lb for steers and \$0.30/lb for swine, but will be determined prior to the sale.

If you would like to support our local youth in agriculture but are unable to participate in the sale in-person or online, please complete the following section and we will assign a proxy bidder for you. You and/or your company will receive recognition for your contribution.

If you purchase an animal(s), you have three options:

Option 1 - Sell the animal to a packer at market price

Option 2 - Pay to process the animal and donate the meat to a charity of your choice

Option 3 - Pay to process the animal and keep the meat for personal consumption

Suggested contribution amounts:

\$5,000 per steer if selling back

\$6,000 per steer if processing for donation or personal consumption

\$1,500 per hog if selling back

\$2,000 per hog if processing for donation or personal consumption
