Online Entry Deadline: December 10, 2023

**Please note: the show will be limited to 150 paid exhibitors – first come first served
Exhibitor must live in or be enrolled in a school in Polk County (Kindergarten to 12th Grade students)*

Show Entry Fee: \$35 per animal

Showmanship Entry Fee: \$20

Tagging deadline: January 13, 2024 at midnight

Entry Rules

- A valid Official Health Certificate must be presented at check-in. State of Florida Health Certificates are valid for 90 days.
- Due to State of Florida requirements, **all GILTS** 6 months or older must be bled – even if they are not going to the sale.
- Per the USDA, ALL swine registering must be tagged with an official ID/840 tag. Animal will not be permitted to show without an 840 tag.
- Owner is responsible for the daily care of his/her animal.
- There will be no refunds on entry fees.
- No boar entries will be accepted.
- Exhibitor may enter up to 2 market animals – **only one market animal may be checked-in to the show.**
- Address where pig will be raised and cared for by the exhibitor on a daily basis must be listed on the entry form. Failure to raise pig at this location will result in disqualification.

Tagging

- Tagging deadline: January 13, 2024 at midnight. On your entry form, you will select the location to pick up your ear tag. Ear tags will be distributed after the December 10th registration deadline. Exhibitor is responsible for tagging their own animal. *If you need assistance, please contact a swine committee member.*

- **Exhibitor Meeting** will be on the morning of the show at 8:30 AM.
- Exhibitor must keep his/her pen space as clean as possible. **All manure and trash must be cleaned before leaving the show. No exceptions!**
- **No shavings** – the facility does not allow.
- Our committee members will be there to help during the show, but exhibitor is responsible for getting their animal to the show ring for the show.
- Exhibitor is responsible for providing water for their animal. Concrete pens will have waterers.
- Exhibitors may wash animal in the designated wash areas.
- Show classes will be no larger than 10 pigs
- Committee members reserve the right to disqualify exhibitors due to safety issues if needed.
- Show management is in no way responsible for exhibits or any accidents that may occur.
- Disrespectful, vulgar, inappropriate behavior – including but not limited to language, underage drinking, disrespectful interaction with adults, judges, committee, or peers will not be tolerated. Participating in any of these activities will be grounds for immediate disqualification. The final decision of the committee will be non-negotiable.
- CFYIA highly discourages, does not condone, and will not permit aggressive behavior towards animal; this includes but is not limited to striking or hitting any animal. As good stewards of livestock, aggressive striking is not an option or practice. Any exhibitor or anyone assisting an exhibitor is not allowed to aggressively or loudly “pop, slap, hit or strike” their animal at any time during the event. If such behavior is witnessed, the first offense will be handled with a warning. The second offense will result in disqualification of the exhibitor and all entry fees and/or prize money will be forfeited. Protests to the disqualification will not be permitted. **If the behavior is determined to be overly aggressive by the swine committee, there will be no warning and will lead to immediate disqualification**

Showmanship Rules

- Showmanship is not mandatory.
- Showmanship will be limited to one entry per exhibitor. Showmanship deadline at time of check-in.
- Exhibitor **must** show their own market animal/breeding gilt for showmanship (exception – adaptive showmanship division).

Divisions:

Exhibitor age will be determined by January 1, 2024.

Novice (8 and under)

Junior (9 – 11)

Intermediate (12 – 15)

Senior (16+)

Adaptive Showmanship (5-18) This division can borrow an animal and is free to enter. Must be enrolled in Polk County school.

Livestock Sale

Exhibitor has the **right to sell one animal** (heifer/bull/steer/hog) in the Livestock Sale on Saturday, March 23rd. This event is a non-terminal show, meaning at time of entry the exhibitor will decide what animal they would like to sell. Selling your animal is OPTIONAL and not required to participate in all divisions of the Central Florida Youth in Agriculture Livestock Showcase & Sale. **Only one animal will be allowed to sell per exhibitor.** A commission will be charged for all animals that enter the sale. CFYIA will receive no more than 5% sale commission of the sale price and that will be determined after the close out of the sale.

- All non-sale animals must be out of the barn prior to sale day
- All sale animals must be in the barn prior to the sale on Saturday
- Withdraw periods must be followed per label on medications.
- **Sale is optional** - If exhibitor chooses the sale option on entry form, animal **MUST** go to sale
- Exhibitor must market his/her own animal. If animal is not in the prospect sale, exhibitor may sell private treaty.
All animals will sell by the Head, not by the pound: (Example - \$5000 – Steer) (\$2500 – Heifer) (\$1500 – Hog)
