## Guide to How You Can Participate in The Youth Livestock Sale



Saturday, March 23rd at 5 p.m. Live Auction

- You may attend in person on Saturday, March 23rd at 5:00 p.m.
- If you are not able to join in person, you can fill out a Buyer's Commitment Form and we can call you when the exhibitor you are interested in helping will be in the ring for the sale or you can do a proxy bid before the sale.
- Call our Bid Line at 863-733-5030 and we can take your bids over the phone.
- Sale Order will be Market Steers followed by Market Hogs.
- Your purchase from the youth livestock sale is eligible for a tax-deduction/charitable gift and helps support youth with their project and encourages them to stay involved in agriculture. Therefore, consult your tax advisor on what deductible amount will be.
- All animals will be sold by the head.
- The following is estimated averages that a Swine and Steer Exhibitor would need to break-even on their project:

Swine - \$3.80 per pound or \$1050 per head Steer - \$2.50 per pound or \$3,450 per head

Again, this is an estimated break-even price and does not account for the youth's labor in the project, so by paying above these prices, you are helping these exhibitors make a profit on their projects.

Don't have time to participate in the sale, but want to help kids with their project, just call us or
donate on our website and we will put your money to good use for the kids and report back to you
on how you were able to help youth in agriculture. You can also donate the meat from the project to
a local charity, such as Lighthouse Ministries, Salvation Army, Talbot House & Florida Baptist
Children's Home, etc., or other charities of your choice and we will help you with this process from
the meat packer.

These are merely suggestions of local meat processors. It is the responsibility of the buyer to arrange transportation of animals to their chosen processor. We will have Nettles and Osteen's on site at our inperson auction who will offer transportation should you elect to use their services.

Resell to Packer – Packer price per pound will be set at beginning of sale. As the buyer of the animal, if you don't wish to receive the meat, you can allow the Packer to receive the animal and you will be responsible for paying the bid price minus the set packer price.
